

# Record expectations for exports open the way for even more protagonism from the Brazilian ports and terminals

Growth potential in Brazil will pass through the investments made in technology, in order to gain greater operational efficiency, which have become high priority for the country's port industry

April 1, 2024, Sao Paulo, Brazil - In Q1 2024, Brazil's exports increased by 4.7% compared to the same period in 2023, reaching US\$ 65.57 billion with imports increasing by 0.6% hitting a total of US\$ 50.05 billion.

According to the Brazilian Ministry of Development, Industry and Foreign Trade, the year 2024 has started with intense activity for the country with regard to international trade. In comparison to January of last year, trade volume grew by 18.5%. The ministry's expectation is that Brazil's sets another record with its exports in 2024 with a projection of reaching US\$ 348 billion.

This positive scenario places the planning of the port industry as an increasingly strategic component to Brazil's economic development. The implementation of innovation and technology, as a driver for greater operational efficiency and increased optimization of resources and processes, has become a strong focus for the leadership and management teams in the port industry throughout the country.

Within this context of opportunity and evolution for the port industry, the first edition of the **Port Performance Summit Brasil 2024** will be held in Sao Paulo, Brazil on October 2-3 at the AMCHAM Business Center.
